## **Reminders**

### **Key Stage 2 pupils**

KS2 pupils are able to enter the lower KS2 playground from 8.30am when the gates are opened, and should wait there until 8.45am when the bell goes. Y3 , Y4 and Y5 pupils should enter the building through the door by the Y4 classrooms, and Y6 pupils through the door leading to the Y6 corridor. Two teachers are on duty on the KS2 playground and at the Y4 door, from 8.45am; class teachers are busy in the mornings, welcoming pupils into class and getting the day off to a positive start, so messages for class teachers can be passed on via the duty staff. Alternatively, parents can go to the main school office and speak to a member of the office staff.

### **Appointments during school time**

If your child has a medical appointment during the school day, please can parents inform the school office directly, providing a copy of the appointment letter/card: this is required so that medical appointments can be marked as an authorised absence.

### **Visitors in school**

All staff and visitors to the school must sign in before they can be admitted to the school building. Can I remind parents that they should only enter the school building via the main office. This is a key part of our safeguarding duty and I am sure all parents will support us in ensuring that safeguarding procedures are adhered to.
