# Welcome back!

Welcome back to the new school year! I hope the children enjoyed the summer break and are ready for another busy and successful year. I would like to welcome new families who have joined St Peter's this September. The boys and girls in Nursery and Reception have made a very positive start and I am sure they will settle into our school very quickly.

We officially became part of Future Generation Trust on 1st September, and we are now St Peter's CE Primary Academy! We are very proud that our new school badge features not only St Peter's keys but also the name of 'Hednesford', as it recognises that we are part of the Church community, and also part of the wider community of Hednesford.

Other than a slight name change, for us, it is business as usual! The school has been a hive of activity over the summer break; not only have the teaching staff been busy preparing the classrooms for their new classes, our Site Supervisor Mr Holroyd has been re-furbishing the Keystones building. As well as installing brand new toilets, he is installing a kitchen and decorating the interior; you may have already noticed that Mr Holroyd has also painted the outside of the building. We have had a new 'Keystones' sign installed as well as a new front door. The Keystones building is used by our Keystones before and after school club, and we are committed to ensuring that the children who use that facility have a lovely environment, just as we have in school. In addition, Mr Holroyd has co-ordinated the contractors who have completed some electrical work, some external rendering, and fitted new signs in and around school. ## **Drinking Water in School....Let's Stay Hydrated!**

From **Y1 upwards** children are welcome to bring in a **clearly named drinking bottle** to have available in their class room so that they can access a drink of **water** during lessons. Only bottles with 'sports caps' are permissible as these reduce the likelihood of spillages on clothing and pupils' books. Children can then re-fill their bottles as necessary from the drinking water taps available in every classroom.

Fruit juice and squash type drinks are not suitable to drink in lessons, but can be brought in to drink at play time and with packed lunches.

Children in **Nursery and Reception** do not require a water bottle as drinking water and cups, as well as milk and fruit, are available at all times as part of the 'snack bar'.

#### **Break-time snacks**

If they wish to, pupils from **Year 1 to Year 6** can buy milk (20p a carton) and toast (25p a slice) at morning break. (Please bring change, if possible, in a named purse.)

#### Sunscreen

In the event of some late summer sun (!), we would advise parents to apply a thorough application of high factor sunscreen, or sun block, before pupils come to school, and to provide a suitable sun hat, sunglasses, etc (all named please), for children to wear when they go outside. If you wish your child to apply further sunscreen during the day then we recommend that you show your child how to do this as school staff are unable to apply sunscreen to pupils. It is important that pupils understand that they should not share sunscreen with other children. Please label sunscreen clearly with your child's name. Thank you.

Key Stage 2 pupils are able to enter the lower playground from 8.30am when the gates are opened, and should wait there until 8.45am when the doors are opened. Y3, Y4 and Y5 pupils should enter the building through the door by the Y4 classrooms, and Y6 pupils through the door leading to the Y6 corridor. Two teachers are on duty on the KS2 playground from 8.45am, so messages for class teachers can be passed on via these staff, or parents can go to the main school office and speak to a member of the office staff. Can I remind parents that they should only enter the school building via the main office, after signing in. This is a key part of our safeguarding procedures and I am sure all parents will support us in ensuring that safeguarding procedures are adhered to.
